

## STEM CLASSROOM CASH SUBMISSIONS – CLOSING DATE EXTENDED

- Due to the current COVID-related lockdown, we are currently not accepting hand-delivered entries and travel is restricted within a certain radius and for essential purposes only.
- **Consequently, we have extended the submission deadline for STEM Classroom Cash to 5PM FRIDAY JULY 23, 2021 (end of week 1 of Term 3).**
- The draw will now take place during the week beginning July 26, 2021 and winners will be announced in *The West Australian* on Thursday, August 5, 2021.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: Entries for your school must be submitted in one package, with the [tally sheet](#) completed. Due to the volume of entries, your entry will be deemed invalid without this (per T&Cs #12).**
- Should there be further COVID-related impacts on the competition, we will advise accordingly.

### STEM Classroom Cash promotion 2021 Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter, prize details and other information contained within the website form part of these terms and conditions.
2. Schools must nominate one person as coordinator who will collect and submit the entries as a single lot at the completion of the competition.
3. Promotion is valid for WA schools only.
4. A valid entry consists of any one entry coupon appearing in *The West Australian* on May 22, May 29, June 4 or June 12 2021 completed by a school registered for STEM Classroom Cash.
5. Only original entry coupons published in *The West Australian* are valid. Photocopies and facsimiles are not valid. Only print editions of *The West Australian* are valid for this promotion.
6. Each entry coupon must be clearly marked with the school's details to be eligible for the random prize draws.
