

## **“WIN a class trip to Wheatstone” promotion Terms and Conditions**

By entering the **“WIN a class trip to Wheatstone” promotion** (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

### **1. STANDARD TERMS**

1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry.

### **2. WHO CAN ENTER?**

2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all teachers actively teaching in a registered school in Western Australia whose class can attend the Wheatstone school excursion on a date to be determined by the prize providers.

2.2 Employees (and their immediate families) of Seven Network (Operations) Limited, West Australian Newspapers, prize suppliers and their respective associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.

### **3. HOW TO ENTER**

3.1 The Competition commences on **Monday 20 March 2023 00:00 AWST** and concludes on **Thursday 6 April 2023 at 17:00 AWST** (“Competition Period”).

3.4 To enter the competition you must email [info@mediaeducation.com.au](mailto:info@mediaeducation.com.au) with the subject line “Wheatstone competition” and email body with your response to “Tell us in 200 words why your STEM students are the right group to experience this amazing tour”.

3.5 It is a condition of entry that the entrant seeks approval from their school Principal / administration that they have approval to take students on this excursion should they be selected as a winner. Teachers and school administrators are advised to review the Excursion Management Plan as part of determining their approval.

3.6 Neither the Promoters nor any prize suppliers are responsible for any data or other information related to this competition that may be lost, damaged as a result of any computer software or hardware malfunction. Any issues occurring as a result of computer / server/ software problems will be rectified as quickly as possible.

3.7 If any entries are deemed at the Promoter’s final discretion to be made via “scripting”, those entries will be deemed invalid and will not be accepted.

### **4. PRIZES**

4.1 There will be **one (1)** prize winner, selected on the merit of their 200 word submission, who will receive the prize package detailed in clause 4.2.

4.2 The prize winner will receive a class day trip to Chevron operated Wheatstone natural gas facility on a date to be determined by the prize providers for up to 32 students and 3 supervising adults including:

- 4.2.1 Return flights from Perth to Onslow
- 4.2.2 Guided tour of the Wheatstone natural gas facility at Ashburton North, including plant control, turbine workshop and laboratory
- 4.2.3 In-flight meals and catered lunch
- 4.2.4 Supplied personal protective equipment
- 4.2.5 Merchandise and learning material pack

4.3 Total maximum prize pool value is up to AUD **\$25,000.00**. Prize value is correct at the date of printing. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for change in prize value between now and the ultimate date on which the prize is taken.

4.4 It is the responsibility of the teacher and school to collect all required parental/guardian consent, in line with the documentation provided by the Promoter, as well as any other documentation relating to consent and release required. The Promoter bears no responsibility or liability for the safety or wellbeing of any child who partakes in the prize package.

4.5 Travel to and from Perth airport is not included in this prize.

4.6 Prize must be taken abiding by all COVID-19 restrictions and guidelines. The Promoter takes no responsibility for Excursion day being cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions changing and prize will be forfeited.

4.7 Time and carrier of flights is at the sole discretion of the Prize provider.

- 4.8 In the event that for any reason whatsoever a winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize.
- 4.9 Unless expressly stated in these Terms and Conditions all other expenses related to the Prize become the responsibility of the Prize Winner. All costs associated with the Prize which are not expressly stated in these Terms and Conditions to be included are the responsibility of the Winners.
- 4.10 Prize may not be transferred or assigned except by the Promoter. Prize cannot be used in conjunction with any other promotion or offer.
- 4.11 It is a condition of entry that all prize winners agree to have their name, photo, video and suburb published for publicity purposes if required. The Prize winner must participate in and co-operate with all reasonable media editorial requests, including but not limited to, being interviewed and photographed, and the Winner grants the Promoters and prize suppliers a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to use such footage and photographs in all media worldwide and the Winners will not be entitled to any fee for such use. This includes all students participating in the Prize, with parental consent for student publicity for all students required for the prize to be accepted.
- 4.12 The prize winner will not sell or otherwise provide their story and/or photographs to any media or other organisation.
- 4.13 It is a condition of accepting the Prize that the prize winner must comply with all the conditions of use of the Prize and the Promoter's requirements.
- 4.14 The prize winner must provide valid identification to the Promoter upon the Promoters request. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the prize at the Promoter's sole discretion.
- 4.15 The promoter is not responsible for the cancellation, delay or rescheduling of any part of a travel or accommodation component of Prize and any costs incurred by Winner or any travelling companion as a result (including accommodation costs) will be the responsibility of the Winner.
- 4.16 By entering the competition, and by collecting a prize, the winner acknowledges and accepts that driving, travel and any other activities comprising the prize, are inherently dangerous and may result in death, injury, incapacity, damage to property or other losses. - 4.19 Subject to state permit authority restrictions, the Promoter may reasonably amend these terms and conditions, orally or in writing, in its absolute discretion.
- 4.20 The prize provider is Chevron Australia.

## **5. HOW TO WIN**

- 5.1 There will be **one (1)** winner. A valid entry consists of a 200 word or less submission from a teacher actively teaching in a registered school in Western Australia.
- 5.2 The winner will be selected at Newspaper House, 50 Hasler Rd, Osborne Park 6017 WA on **Wednesday 12 April 2023 10:00 (AWST)**.
- 5.3 A member of the Seven West Media (WA) Media Education department will contact the prize winners by a phone call and an email advising the prize winner of their prize will also be emailed to the email address on the entry. The winner's entry details will be published on [thewest.com.au/STEM](http://thewest.com.au/STEM) from **Friday 14 April 2023**.
- 5.4 The Prize winner has 48 hours to acknowledge the prize and confirm that a class is able to accept the prize and attend the excursion on the date to be determined by the prize providers. In the event that this does not occur, the prize will be forfeited and another winner drawn.
- 5.5 The Promoter's decision is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the result.
- 5.6 The Promoter may in its absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a prize winner being notified or a prize winner's name being announced if it is discovered that the prize winner did not enter the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions. In these circumstances, an additional draw will be conducted.

## **6. NO LIABILITY**

- 6.1 In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the Promoter's ability to proceed with the Competition on the dates and in the manner described in these terms and conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, pandemic, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions, subject to state government legislation.
