Purpose

This document provides information to assist the teacher-in-charge to complete TEMPLATE 1: LOCAL AREA EXCURSION: PROPOSAL FOR LOCAL AREA EXCURSION, in accordance with the Department of Education's EXCURSIONS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROCEDURES, LOCAL AREA EXCURSIONS guidelines and any related documents.

Educational purpose

As Resources Technology Showcase 2023 presenting partner, Chevron Australia – together with Seven West Media – is offering Western Australian STEM students an exclusive opportunity to experience one of Australia's most significant resource projects, the Chevron Australia-operated Wheatstone natural gas facility.

Students will tour a world-class natural gas plant, learn about the energy that powers homes and industry across Western Australia and experience what it's like to live and work in the remote Pilbara region.

Risk assessment

Please use the information contained within this document to help you to complete your risk assessment.

Students' capacity and health care

The Wheatstone natural gas facility and Onslow town are remote areas with limited medical support facilities. It is the responsibility of the school to ensure students and supervisors are fit for travel and participation prior to commencing the excursion and have adequate medications / medical supplies as required.

The Wheatstone LNG Plant is in a remote part of the Western Australia Pilbara region and some medical services are not as readily available as in the city. Visitors with a medical condition should carry with them a detailed letter from their treating physician that can be provided in the event medical support is required. Currently Wheatstone does not have any vehicles with wheelchair access.

Note that no syringes and/or needles or injectable medications should be carried unless they are prefilled injection devices (auto-injectors or pens) and their cartridges, such as insulin or adrenaline, or they are authorized to do so by the Chevron Australia Chief Medical Officer.

Supervisory team

Duty of Care for students rests with the school at all times. It is a requirement for the school to provide a supervisory team ('School Supervisors') for this excursion, taking into account the needs and abilities of the students and adequate adult:child ratios.

We recommend a ratio of 1:10 at a minimum, with at least three adults in case of emergencies. It is the school's responsibility to ensure all School Supervisors have appropriate clearances for working with children.

Working with children checks

During the excursion, Chevron Australia personnel (including from external agencies) may lead, demonstrate, perform and present activities but will not undertake any role(s) in a supervisory context. Chevron Australia personnel are not in child-related work within the meaning of the Working With Children (Criminal Record Checking) Act 2004 and are not required to have Working With Children (WWC) Checks. It is expected that School Supervisors will be responsible for your group at all times and will hold WWC Checks.

Supervision strategies

Supervision

The Wheatstone natural gas facility is a designated Major Hazard Facility. Students and School Supervisors will be accompanied by and under the direction of Chevron Australia personnel at all times.

School Supervisors are responsible for monitoring the physical wellbeing and behaviour of students at all times. School Supervisors must accompany students throughout the excursion, actively monitor behaviour and intervene as necessary.

First aid

The Chevron Health and Medical Centre at the Wheatstone Operations Building will administer first aid treatment and assistance if required. It is the responsibility of School Supervisors to make Chevron Australia event personnel aware of any required first aid assistance.

Missing / lost children

School Supervisors who have a missing child should notify Chevron Australia event personnel immediately. Any lost children should make themselves known to Chevron Australia personnel.

Schools are reminded the excursion will take place at a designated Major Hazard Facility. It is the School Supervisors' responsibility to monitor the whereabouts of students at all times and ensure compliance with all directions given by Chevron Australia personnel for the safety of students and the School Supervisors.

Photography and filming

Students and School Supervisors are not permitted to take photographs or videos at the Wheatstone natural gas facility, including the gas plant and Operations Building.

During the excursion, photography and video content will be captured by Chevron Australia and Seven West Media for editorial or promotional use, including print, online or television.

Permission to film or photograph students and School Supervisors for these purposes is implied by your attendance. It is the school's responsibility to manage this in terms of students who cannot be filmed or photographed.

Roads and vehicles

Schools are reminded the excursion will take place at an industrial facility where normal operations will continue to be carried out – this includes areas where moving vehicles may be present. Supervision of students remains the responsibility of the School Supervisors, and all road and pedestrian traffic signals and directions must be adhered to by students and School Supervisors at all times.

Identification of excursion participants

Throughout the excursion, identification of participants is the responsibility of School Supervisors. Students will be required to wear personal protective equipment during the excursion, as outlined in 'Briefing students and supervisors' below.

Student information

It is the responsibility of the School Supervisors to maintain a list of participating students, their associated emergency contact details and health information. At a minimum, a copy should be held by School Supervisors and also be kept at the school in case of emergency.

Communications strategies

Megaphones, air horns, school two-way radios or whistles are not permitted to be used during the excursion.

Throughout the excursion, students will remain under the supervision of School Supervisors, with a maintained ratio of 10:1, as well as Chevron Australia event personnel.

Briefing students and supervisors

COVID-19

At time of excursion, students and School Supervisors must not be sick or unwell.

Students or School supervisors who do not meet these criteria are not eligible for participation.

Prohibited items

Items which may be a potential ignition source such as cigarette lighters, matches, cameras, Fitbits, smart watches, fitness trackers, Bluetooth headphones and other non-essential, wearable and transmitting devices will not be permitted on site.

Personal items such as mobile phones, iPads and tablets are to be switched off and remain stowed away while touring the Wheatstone natural gas facility.

Valuables

It is recommended participants minimise the amount of belongings they take on the excursion as event coordinators are unable to guarantee the security of any valuables, including mobile phones or personal devices.

School bags

School bags are not permitted during the excursion. Students will receive a learning pack including materials needed to complete excursion activities and other items.

Attire and personal protective equipment

Students and School Supervisors will be provided with safety glasses, a high visibility vest and hard hat for the duration of the site tour and where otherwise appropriate during the excursion. Personal protective equipment must be worn at all times, as directed by Chevron Australia event staff.

All students and supervisors must present at point of travel in the below attire – to be supplied by participant:

- Long sleeve shirt (ideally cotton or similar fabric, appropriate for hot weather conditions)
- Long trousers (ideally cotton or similar fabric, appropriate for hot weather conditions)
- Enclosed shoes.

Duration

The excursion will total approximately 12 hours, including travel time.

Behaviour

Schools are reminded the excursion will take place at an industrial facility where normal operations will be occurring. Appropriate behaviour and adherence to all safety direction is expected to ensure an enjoyable and safe experience for all participants.

Catering

In-flight meals and catered lunch will be provided. It is the responsibility of the school to advise event staff of any dietary requirements at least seven (7) days prior to the excursion. It is also the responsibility of School Supervisors to monitor adherence to dietary requirements during the excursion.

Weather

Please check local forecasts before your excursion and plan accordingly. Conditions are likely to be warm, please be mindful of sun protection and hydration levels.

Transport arrangements

The excursion includes paid flights for up to 32 students and 4 school supervisors, travelling return from Cobham Aviation Domestic Terminal (Perth) to Onslow Airport (Onslow) – please see Appendix A for draft itinerary.

Transport arrangements for students and School Supervisors to and from Cobham Aviation Domestic Terminal is the responsibility of the school. Please ensure all participants are assembled at Cobham Aviation Terminal at the designated arrival time, as outlined in Appendix B.

All transport arrangements in Onslow and at the Wheatstone natural gas facility are the responsibility of the event coordinator.

Luggage

School Supervisors are permitted one light carry-on bag per person, not exceeding 7kg. Please note, school bags are not permitted on the excursion – see 'School bags' above.



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


